In preparing for reentry, HTCS faculty and staff worked to facilitate instruction for both on-campus and distance-learning students. Numerous physical improvements were made to our site. The additional technology for students and teachers, as well as physical upgrades to our campus, came with a cost.

As our country suffers through the pandemic, many parents are facing financial burdens and hardships as well. Due to these factors Holy Trinity Catholic School decided not to increase tuition for the 2020/2021 school year. As you know, tuition for your child is \$7550. What you may not know is that the actual cost to educate your child at Holy Trinity is \$14,000. Essentially you and every parent paying tuition are receiving a gift of \$6450 this year. The funds used to complete your child's "real tuition cost" come from Holy Trinity Parish, the Gala, generous donors and the Annual Campaign. A donation to the Annual Campaign shows a commitment and dedication to meet the needs in our current operating budget by helping us to sustain and improve our school and continue to provide affordable tuition.

Please help us reach this year's Annual Campaign pledge goal of \$30,000. We are asking for 100% participation from HTCS families.
